











With its rich cultural and natural heritage, Sindh provides an ideal platform fr craftsmenship. Handicraft making has been one of the main livelihood sources of the inhabitants, after agriculture and livestock rearing. The Indus Ecoregion in Sindh, in particular, boasts a diverse range of traditional craft, such as handloom weaving, block

printing, needle embroidery, patchwork, appliqué, pottery, furniture and artwork on clay products. There is a wide range of products within each of these product techniques. They are recognized for its value at a national and international level.

However, with the introduction of mechanized tools and machines, stagnancy in handicraft design and lack of product innovation, the demand for traditional products has declined rapidly, harming efforts for preservation of cultural heritage and livelihood of local artisans.

Under Indus for All Programme of World Wide Fund for Nature -Pakistan, livelihood development plans were implemented in four ecologically critical sites of Indus Ecoregion, namely Keti Bunder (Thatta district), Keenihar Lake (Thatta district), Pai Forest (Shaheed Benazirabad district) and Chotiari Reservoir (Sanghar district). Local handicrafts were promoted through establishment of vocational centres and shops for 150 local women. To ensure its success, trainings were given in product development: color combination, design development, quality material use, motif placement and development of contemporary products with modern touch without losing indigenous essence of skills. The skilled artisans are being trained further as entrepreneurs through capacity building in negotiation, skills selling, record keeping and income expenditure calculation. These women were also given exposure to potential outlets / markets (e.g. Expo exhibitions) and working with brands (e.g. Gul Ahmed and Alkaram Textiles). Linkages with relevant organizations (e.g. Sindh Indigenous and Traditional Crafts Company and Aik Hunar Aik Nagar) have been formed, for further production and marketing support. These efforts have resulted in empowering women for sustainable development and providing livelihood alternatives for women living in rural greas of Indus Ecoregion.
